7. If you're going on holiday to Perth, you'll be 2 hours behind Eastern Australian time. If the NRL Grand Final starts at 7:15 pm, Eastern Australian time, what time would you need to watch it if you're in Sydney?

8. A special 1-litre can contains 956 jelly beans. How many jelly beans would there be altogether in 5 of these cans?



9. Open-ended Question: At the AFL Grand Final, there were twice as many adults watching as children. If there was a crowd of 98,000, and there were more men than women, how many women may there have been watching the match?
