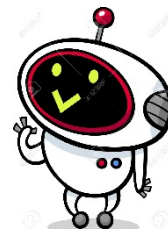


4. The Olympic Games have just ended! If they started on the 5th of August and ended on the 21st of August, how many weeks and days did they go for?
