1. The population of India increased from 870 million in 1990 to 1.25 billion in 2013. How big was that increase, in figures?







- 3. The Eurovision Song Contest 2016 was won by the Ukraine contestant, Jamala, who got 534 points. It beat Australia's singer Dami Im by just 23 points. What was Australia's score?
- 4. A special day, called "Kids' Tracky Dack Day", has been launched by 16-year-old Lucy, in aid of kids suffering from cystic fibrosis. If that day is held on May 26th, how many days is that BEFORE Christmas Day, 2016 (December 25th)?



- 5. During the current election campaign, if Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull manages to cuddle 3 babies per day for each day in the 8-week election campaign, how many babies will that be in total?
- 6. People who thought they were being ripped off with their electricity and gas bills complained at the rate of 900 complaints a day on average. How many complaints would that amount to in one full year (not a leap year)?
- 7. It is an interesting fact that the Australian continent moves north at a rate of 3 cm a year. At that rate, how far north will Australia move in 8 decades (answer in metres and centimetres)?



- 8. A series of 6 football action "Bobbleheads" have been produced. If 2/3 of them are very poor likenesses of the real footballers, how many Bobbleheads are really good likenesses?
- 9. Ed's Dad drives on country roads at an average speed of 90 kph for 2.5 hours, and then for 1.5 hours at 110 kph. How far does he travel in total?
- 10. <u>Open-Ended Question:</u> Can you copy the image on the right without ever lifting your pen from the paper, or tracing over any of the lines? (Note: It <u>IS</u> possible!)
